

EX-CORMAN EXEC TO YORK

Jones named general manager at company

JAN. 13 | Gary Jones, formerly home entertainment president at Roger Corman's New Concorde, has been tapped general manager at York Entertainment.

In late 2004, York underwent a general assignment, considered an alternative to filing for bankruptcy liquidation under Chapter 7 of the U.S. Bankruptcy Act. Loose Cannon acquired York's assets for \$90,000 and is the distribution company for the York Entertainment label.

Jones will oversee day-to-day York operations, including sales, marketing and distribution of York's 50-plus titles slated for a 2006 release.

Prior to his New Concorde stint, Jones was senior VP domestic home video at Trimark Pictures.

"I'm thrilled to have Gary as part of the York team," York chief Tanya York said. "I'm confident his vast experience and dedication will be integral in strengthening our position as the leading independent distributor of home entertainment."
